

Information on investment management of pension assets of UAPF JSC, which are in trust management of Halyk Finance Subsidiary of Halyk Bank of Kazakhstan JSC

As of May 01, 2024 pension assets (hereinafter referred to as PA) of the UAPF held in trust by Halyk Finance Subsidiary of Halyk Bank of Kazakhstan JSC (hereinafter referred to as a) amounted to **KZT29,896.97 mln.**

The structure of the portfolio of financial instruments formed from pension assets held in trust by Halyk Finance is shown in Table 1.

Reverse repo operations (no more than 90 calendar days)

The current value of reverse repo transactions for the reporting month amounted to KZT15,528.92 mln. Their share in the portfolio was 51.94%.

The weighted average return on reverse repo transactions as of the reporting date was 14.37%.

Government securities of the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Kazakhstan

During the reporting period, government securities of the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Kazakhstan (hereinafter referred to as the government securities of the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Kazakhstan) were not purchased as part of the portfolio.

The current value of government securities of the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Kazakhstan for the reporting month amounted to KZT530.51 mln. Their share in the portfolio was 1.77%.

The weighted average yield of government securities of the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Kazakhstan as of the reporting date was 12.15% per annum.

Notes of the National Bank of the Republic of Kazakhstan

During the reporting period, notes of the National Bank of the Republic of Kazakhstan (hereinafter referred to as NBRK) were not purchased as part of the portfolio. There are no NBRK notes in the portfolio as of the reporting date.

Government securities of foreign countries

During the reporting period, discount US Treasury bonds were purchased in the amount of 145 thousand US dollars at par value.

The current value of government securities of foreign countries at the end of the reporting month amounted to KZT1,905.48 mln. Their share in the portfolio was 6.37%.

The weighted average yield to maturity of government securities of foreign countries as of the reporting date was 4.76% per annum in US dollars.

Bonds of international financial organizations

During the reporting period, bonds of international financial organizations were not purchased as part of the portfolio.

The current value of bonds of international financial organizations (hereinafter referred to as IFOs) at the end of the reporting month amounted to KZT1,338.72 mln. Their share in the portfolio was 4.48%.

Corporate bonds of resident issuers of the Republic of Kazakhstan

During the reporting period, corporate bonds of resident issuers of the Republic of Kazakhstan were not purchased as part of the portfolio.

The current value of corporate bonds of resident issuers of the Republic of Kazakhstan at the end of the reporting month amounted to KZT24.09 mln. Their share in the portfolio was 0.08%.

Bonds of second-tier banks of the Republic of Kazakhstan

During the reporting period, bonds of second-tier banks of the Republic of Kazakhstan (hereinafter referred to as STB RK) were not purchased as part of the portfolio.

The current value of bonds of STBs of the Republic of Kazakhstan at the end of the reporting month amounted to KZT991.65 mln. Their share in the portfolio was 3.32%.

The weighted average yield to maturity of bonds of STBs of the Republic of Kazakhstan as of the reporting date was 14.46% per annum.

Bonds of quasi-public organizations of the Republic of Kazakhstan

During the reporting period, bonds of quasi-public organizations of the Republic of Kazakhstan were not purchased as part of the portfolio.

The current value of bonds of quasi-public organizations of the Republic of Kazakhstan at the end of the reporting month amounted to KZT2,896.95 mln. Their share in the portfolio was 9.69%.

The weighted average yield to maturity of bonds of quasi-public organizations of the Republic of Kazakhstan as of the reporting date was 12.84% per annum.

Foreign corporate bonds

During the reporting period, JBS USA Finance coupon bonds in the amount of \$1 million at par value were purchased as part of the portfolio.

The current value of corporate bonds of foreign issuers at the end of the reporting month amounted to KZT2,955.10 mln. Their share in the portfolio was 9.88%.

The weighted average yield to maturity of corporate bonds of foreign issuers as of the reporting date was 12.57% per annum in tenge and 6.30% per annum in US dollars.

Shares and depository receipts of issuers of the Republic of Kazakhstan

During the reporting period, shares and depository receipts of issuers of the Republic of Kazakhstan were not purchased as part of the portfolio.

The current value of shares and depository receipts of issuers of the Republic of Kazakhstan at the end of the reporting month amounted to KZT634.37 mln. Their share in the portfolio was 2.12%.

Exchange Traded Funds (ETFs)

During the reporting period, no shares of Exchange Traded Funds (hereinafter referred to as ETFs) were purchased as part of the portfolio.

The current value of the ETF at the end of the reporting month amounted to KZT2,152.49 mln. Their share in the portfolio was 7.20%.

Shares and depository receipts of foreign issuers

During the reporting period, the portfolio acquired common shares of UnitedHealth Group in the amount of 95.6 thousand US dollars, common shares of Becton Dickinson and Co in the amount of 550 thousand US dollars.

The current value of shares and depository receipts of foreign issuers at the end of the reporting month amounted to KZT885.53 mln. Their share in the portfolio was 2.96%.

Currency structure

The investment portfolio of financial instruments by currencies in which financial instruments acquired using pension assets held in trust by Halyk Finance is denominated is presented in Table 2.

Investment results

As a result of investment activities, the amount of accrued investment income since the beginning of 2024 amounted to KZT410.54 mln. The return on pension assets since the beginning of 2024 amounted to 1.81%.

Information on compliance with the parameters of the investment declaration

The structural distribution of UAPF PAs held in trust meets the requirements of the Investment Declaration¹ for a portfolio of financial instruments formed from pension assets held in trust by Halyk Finance. The shares of currency positions remain within the acceptable level and do not violate the requirements of the Investment Declaration for a portfolio of financial instruments
