

Information on investment management of pension assets of UAPF JSC, which are in trust management of Halyk Global Markets JSC

As of June 01, 2025, pension assets (hereinafter referred to as PA) of UAPF JSC (hereinafter referred to as UAPF), which are in trust management of Halyk Global Markets JSC (hereinafter referred to as Halyk Global Markets), amounted to **KZT 5,535.07 mln.**

The structure of the portfolio of financial instruments formed from pension assets held in trust by Halyk Global Markets is presented in Table 1.

As of 01.06.2025, the weighted average yield on debt financial instruments denominated in tenge was 14.32% per annum. The weighted average yield on debt financial instruments denominated in US dollars was 5.62%.

Reverse repo transactions (up to 90 calendar days)

At the end of the reporting period, the total value of open Reverse REPO positions in the Investment Portfolio amounted to KZT1,655.21 mln. Their share in the portfolio was 29.90%. The

average weighted yield on open Reverse REPO positions at the end of the reporting period was 16.12% per annum.

Corporate bonds of foreign issuers

In the reporting period, corporate bonds of foreign issuers were not acquired for the Investment Portfolio and JBS USA/FOOD/FINANCE bonds in the amount of KZT73.27 mln were partially repaid early.

The value of corporate bonds of foreign issuers during the reporting period decreased by KZT72.40 mln and at the end of the reporting period amounted to KZT706.62 mln. The share of corporate bonds of foreign issuers in the portfolio as of June 1, 2025 was 12.77%.

The average weighted yield to maturity of corporate bonds of foreign issuers at the end of the reporting period was 5.81% per annum.

Bonds of second-tier banks of the Republic of Kazakhstan

In the reporting period, bonds of second-tier banks (hereinafter referred to as STB RK) were not purchased for the Investment Portfolio.

The cost of STB RK bonds for the reporting period decreased by KZT31.53 mln and at the end of the reporting period amounted to KZT593.77 mln. Their share in the portfolio as of June 1, 2025 was 10.73%.

The average weighted yield to maturity of STB RK bonds at the end of the reporting period amounted to 14.28% per annum.

Corporate bonds of issuers of the Republic of Kazakhstan

In the reporting period, corporate bonds of issuers of the Republic of Kazakhstan were not acquired for the Investment Portfolio and bonds of KMF Microfinance Organization LLP in the amount of KZT235.5 mln were redeemed.

The value of corporate bonds of issuers of the Republic of Kazakhstan during the reporting period decreased by KZT260.44 mln and amounted to KZT337.22 mln at the end of the reporting period. Their share in the portfolio as of June 1, 2025 was 6.09%.

The average weighted yield to maturity of corporate bonds of issuers of the Republic of Kazakhstan denominated in tenge at the end of the reporting period was - 13.75% per annum.

The average weighted yield to maturity of corporate bonds of issuers of the Republic of Kazakhstan denominated in US dollars at the end of the reporting period was 5.29% per annum.

Government securities of the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Kazakhstan

In the reporting period, government securities of the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Kazakhstan (hereinafter referred to as MF RK GS) were not acquired for the Investment Portfolio.

The value of MF RK GS decreased by KZT2.38 mln during the reporting period and amounted to KZT700.27 mln at the end of the reporting period. Their share in the portfolio as of June 1, 2025 was 12.65%.

The average weighted yield to maturity of MF RK GS denominated in tenge at the end of the reporting period was 15.44% per annum.

Securities with government status issued by central governments of foreign states

In the reporting period, US treasury bonds in the total amount of KZT347.64 mln were acquired for the Investment Portfolio.

The value of securities with the status of government issued by the central governments of foreign states increased by KZT347.44 mln during the reporting period and amounted to KZT486.19 mln at the end of the reporting period. Their share in the portfolio as of June 1, 2025 was 8.78%.

The average weighted yield to maturity of securities with the status of government issued by the central governments of foreign states at the end of the reporting period was 5.38% per annum.

Shares and depositary receipts of issuers of the Republic of Kazakhstan

In the reporting period, shares and depositary receipts of issuers of the Republic of Kazakhstan were not acquired for the Investment Portfolio.

The value of shares and depositary receipts of issuers of the Republic of Kazakhstan increased by KZT3.57 mln during the reporting period and amounted to KZT146.04 mln at the end of the reporting period. Their share in the portfolio as of June 1, 2025 was 2.64%.

Equity instruments of foreign issuers (ETF units)

In the reporting period, equity instruments of foreign issuers (ETF units) were not acquired for the Investment Portfolio.

The value of equity instruments of foreign issuers increased by KZT9.98 mln during the reporting period and amounted to KZT419.81 mln at the end of the reporting period. Their share in the portfolio as of June 1, 2025 was 7.58%.

Bonds of quasi-public organizations of the Republic of Kazakhstan

In the reporting period, bonds of quasi-public organizations of the Republic of Kazakhstan were not acquired for the Investment Portfolio.

The value of bonds of quasi-public organizations of the Republic of Kazakhstan during the reporting period decreased by KZT13.49 mln and amounted to KZT475.96 mln at the end of the reporting period. The share of bonds of quasi-public organizations of the Republic of Kazakhstan in the Investment Portfolio as of June 1, 2025 was 8.60%.

The average weighted yield to maturity of bonds of quasi-public organizations of the Republic of Kazakhstan denominated in tenge at the end of the reporting period amounted to 13.07% per annum.

Currency structure

The structure of the Investment Portfolio by currency at the end of the reporting period is presented in Table 2.

Investment Results

As a result of investment activities, the amount of accrued investment income as of June 1, 2025 from March 15, 2021 was KZT1,415.05 mln and the amount of accrued investment income since the beginning of 2025 was KZT85.41 mln. The return on pension assets since the beginning of operations was 54.61% and since the beginning of 2025 was 1.49%, over the past 12 months from June 2024 to May 2025 amounted 14.85%.
